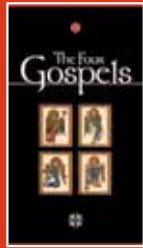
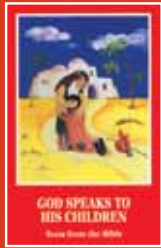

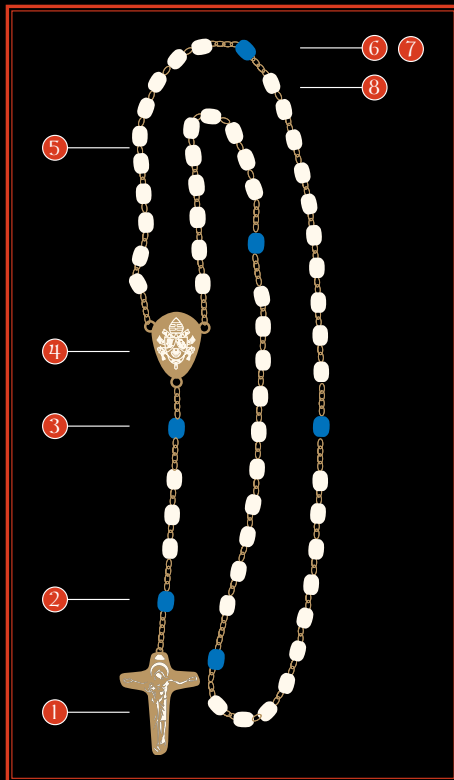

## ROSARY PRAYERS

### The Sign of the Cross

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

### Credo

I Believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of Heaven and earth. I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord; who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified; died, and was buried. He descended to the dead.. The third day He arose again. He ascended into Heaven, is seated at the right hand the Father. He shall come again to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the Communion of Saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.

### Our Father

Our Father, Who art in Heaven, hallowed be Thy name. Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.

## ROSARY BEADS

- 1 Make the Sign of the Cross, say the Credo.
- 2 Say the Our Father.
- 3 Say three Hail Mary's and the Glory Be.
- 4 Name the 1st mystery, and your intention, then the Our Father.
- 5 Say ten Hail Mary's while thinking of the Mystery.
- 6 Say the Glory be. (Optional - After each decade, say the Fatima Prayer).
- 7 Name the 2nd Mystery and your intention, then say the Our Father. Repeat 5, 6 and 7.
- 8 Say the Hail Holy Queen, when the 5 decades are completed.

Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

### Hail Mary

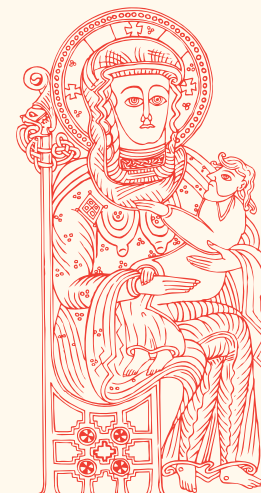
